

Colorado State Innovation Model: Cohort 2

HealthTeamWorks is participating in the 2nd cohort of the Colorado State Innovation Model (SIM) as a Practice Transformation Organization.

SIM provides assistance in integrating behavioral health and primary care to help practices achieve the Quadruple Aim and strives to move practices along the continuum of integrated care. Participating practices receive support to integrate behavioral health into existing care models, embed advanced primary care concepts into practice and test alternative payment models in preparation for the delivery of value-based care.

HealthTeamWorks is formally collaborating with CCHAP to provide in-depth transformation support for family medicine practices focusing on both adult and pediatric behavioral health integration.

Practices selected to participate receive considerable FREE support including:

- A practice facilitator to guide practice improvement team in change and quality improvement activities
- A clinical health information technology advisor (CHITA) to help optimize technology and turn data into actionable information
- Access to a regional health connector, who connects practices to relevant community and state resources
- Access to MGMA's DataDive®, an online data benchmarking tool
- Technical assistance from the University of Colorado
- Opportunity to earn achievement-based payments up to \$13,000 for meeting key activities and milestones
- Small grant funding of up to \$40,000 to support integration efforts (must be applied for)
- Twice-yearly collaborative sessions earn maintenance of certification and continuing medical education credits
- Commitment from at least one payer to support your practice with a value-based payment model

Additional benefits of participating with HealthTeamWorks in SIM include:

- ✓ Expert in-practice coaching from HealthTeamWorks' practice facilitators to help develop high-functioning care teams and prepare to succeed in the Medicare Quality Payment Program.
